This position will join the Criminology and Criminal Justice Program, which is part of the School of Social Work and is housed in the College for Public Health and Social Justice.

Applicants for this position must hold a Ph.D. in Criminology & Criminal Justice, or a related field with a substantive research focus on criminology and criminal justice. Area of specialization is open, however the Criminology and Criminal Justice program is particularly interested in candidates whose research and teaching includes a strong emphasis on racial and/or social justice. Applicants must demonstrate strong potential for and/or high achievement in securing extramural funding, as well as excellence in scholarship and teaching. Primary responsibilities include conducting and publishing research, teaching and student mentoring at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, and professional and university service.

Salary is dependent on qualifications and experience. The hire is a priority for university administration and a competitive start-up package will be included.
