

The Criminal Justice Studies Program at the **University of South Dakota** invites applicants for a one-year visiting position at the **Assistant Professor** rank. Area of specialization is criminology or victimology. The ideal candidate will also have the ability to teach information literacy and research methods and may be asked to deliver some courses online.

The University of South Dakota is the state's flagship liberal arts institution with a "higher research" (R2) Carnegie Classification. We seek a candidate who possesses a commitment to excellence in teaching, student mentoring, and research within the context of a strong liberal arts program. The successful candidate will be expected to maintain an active research agenda, share in the work of a vibrant department and apply his or her professional expertise in the service of the university, community and discipline. The Criminal Justice Studies program enjoys major endowments that support faculty research and international/domestic off-campus study opportunities for its majors.

Applicants must have a Ph.D. in criminal justice and/or criminology on the date of appointment. A J.D. or master's degree alone is insufficient qualification for this position. This is a nine-month position with a start date of August 22, 2020.

Review of applications will begin April 15, 2020 and continue until a suitable candidate is hired. Applications **MUST** be submitted on-line at <https://yourfuture.sdbor.edu>. A complete application consists of a letter of application, current résumé, unofficial graduate transcripts, three letters of reference, teaching portfolio (course evaluations, philosophy of teaching statement, and/or sample syllabi), and at least one article-length writing sample.
